Mind-body programs including yoga, Reiki and empowerment drumming, help patients deal with the complexities of cancer treatment, and rise above the stresses and difficulties of the journey.

"During the past 12 years, the Centre has been able to touch the lives of more than 34,600 patients and families, offering a non-medical setting where they come to celebrate life, deal with hardships and find answers to their questions," said Anthony Andello, director of the Cancer Resource Centre. "Thanks to our good neighbors – the Highland, Merrillville and Crown Point Culver's – many more patients will be able to seek comfort, solace and a new path on their road to recovery."
