FAMILY FEUD TURNS INTO GENEROUS DONATION TO CANCER RESOURCE CENTRE IN MUNSTER

MUNSTER – When Gastroenterologist Gene Chang, M.D. gets together with his family, there's plenty of fun and laughter. There was more of the same this past spring after the Chang family played for big prize money on the nationally syndicated game show, "Family Feud." After the show, Dr. Gene Chang and his wife Eileen returned home and donated \$10,000 of the family's cash prize to the Cancer Resource Centre in Munster.

All programming at the Centre is free, and includes a widevariety of support groups, mind-body classes, lectures, and also a resource room filled with books, videos, and Internet access.

The Centre is a program of the Community Cancer Research Foundation. The foundation works to reduce cancer morbidity and mortality in the region by supporting and advancing cancer detection, diagnosis, treatment, education and prevention efforts of the hospitals of Community Healthcare System.

President of the Community Cancer Research Foundation Board of Directors Don Fesko explained that support from residents and the business community is vital to the Cancer Resource Centre's mission.
